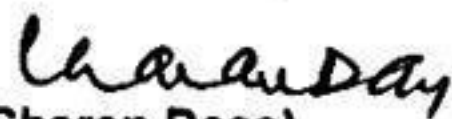
Sir,

With reference to your letter dated 08.09.2014 received in this office on 19.09.2014 on the above subject, I am to inform you as under: -

Q. No.	Reply
1	Kalinga University, Raipur, Chhattisgarh has been established by an Act of State Legislature of Chhattisgarh as a Private University and is empowered to award degrees as specified under Section 22 of the UGC Act through its main campus at regular mode with the approval of Statutory Bodies/Councils, wherever its required. Kalinga University, Raipur, Chhattisgarh is not authorized to open study centre/ off campus centre beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the state as per the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case of Prof. Yashpal Vs. State of Chhattisgarh. The University cannot open its centre(s) even within the state as per the provision of UGC (Establishment of and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003 without the approval of UGC. The UGC has not granted any approval to the University to open off campus/study centre. For information related to Distance Education you are requested to directly approach Distance Education Bureau of UGC, Distance Education Council Building, Indira Gandhi National Open University, Maidan Garhi, Delhi.
2,3,4,5	Ph.D is valid if this course is conducted in regular mode at the main campus of the University and as per the provision contained in the UGC MPhil/Ph.D. Regulation, 2009.
