THE PROBLEM TOPIC ENGINE WAS BUILT TO SOLVE

Every academic year, thousands of Indian PhD scholars spend months — some, entire years — on a topic that eventually collapses at the DRC table: too broad, too close to existing work, or simply undefendable under questioning. The pattern repeats across disciplines and institutions: a scholar falls in love with a subject area rather than a defensible, gap-oriented question.

Not for a lack of intelligence. For a lack of a system to pressure-test an idea seriously, **before** a doctorate is committed to it — against the same regulatory, methodological and originality standards a real DRC will apply. **Topic Engine is that system.**

WHY ONE PASS, NOT MANY

Traditionally, these checks live in different places — a supervisor's memory, an old ordinance PDF, a UGC circular, a discipline's own convention — applied once if at all, and rarely revisited as a topic evolves. Topic Engine runs all thirteen against the same title in a single pass, so nothing is checked twice, nothing quietly falls through, and the same scorecard travels with the topic from generation through to synopsis, proposal and DRC review.

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FRAMEWORK

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Where a Topic Begins

Every idea starts somewhere. These two tools take you from a blank page to a title with a stated research gap, tuned to your own specialization.

WHY IT MATTERS

Most abandoned doctorates trace back to a topic chosen before it was tested. Generate and Boost exist to test it first.

01 Topic Generator

AI-ASSISTED TOPIC IDEATION

Tell it your discipline, degree level and available resources. Topic Generator proposes a doctoral, gap-oriented topic that is genuinely yours to defend — not a recycled title.

- Tuned to your specialization, not a generic subject area
- Descriptive → Analytical → PhD-level gap-oriented, by design
- Every suggestion carries a stated research gap, not just a theme

IN PRACTICE

A first-year scholar with only a discipline and a rough direction leaves the session with several ranked topic options, each carrying its own stated research gap.

02 Topic Booster

ONE STEP AT A TIME

Already have a working title? Boost applies the 8-Rule DRC Model to sharpen it — tightening variables, scope and originality until it reads DRC-ready.

Two very different risks, both fatal at the DRC table: a topic too close to existing work, and a topic that quietly breaks a rule nobody read closely.

Regulations and prior work both move. What clears today can drift out of compliance by the time you submit — these checks are built to be re-run.

Saturation Check

CROSS-SCHOLAR DUPLICATION DETECTION

Duplication is the risk this platform exists to detect. Saturation Check searches live Indian and global research records for the closest existing theses — before your DRC finds them.

- Live from Shodhganga — 6,89,503+ Indian theses, retrieved not guessed
- Ranked by shared title concepts, not keyword matching alone
- Shows precisely how your topic differs from the closest existing work

IN PRACTICE

A topic that looked original on a quick manual search turns out to overlap a thesis submitted elsewhere two years earlier — caught here, at the topic stage, not after the synopsis is filed.

UGC Compliance Check

REGULATION, UNIVERSITY BY UNIVERSITY

Checked against UGC PhD Regulations 2022 and the specific ordinance of your own institution — from IITs and IIMs to state, central and deemed universities.

WHY REHEARSAL BEATS CONFIDENCE

A DRC panel does not ask questions in the order a synopsis presents them, and it rarely asks the question a scholar has already prepared for. The simulation is built the same way — three independent examiners drawing their challenges directly from the specific weak points a Feasibility Index and Saturation Check already found in the topic, so the rehearsal argues with the same rigour the real panel will.

03 Originality ensured

Checked against existing theses before submission, not after.

04 Clear variables defined

Independent, dependent and moderating variables named, not implied.

05 Manageable scope

Sized to what one scholar can complete inside the programme's real timeline.

06 Data availability verified

The data or access it depends on already exists, or a plan exists to get it.

07 Methodological feasibility

The design, instrument and sample are realistic for the resources on hand.

08 Academic / societal issue addressed

Answers a question that matters beyond the thesis itself.

09 Publication potential

Positioned to land in a UGC-CARE or Scopus-indexed journal.

10 New knowledge contributed

Adds something the discipline did not already know, stated plainly.

Every rule above maps to a check already running inside Topic Engine — rules 1–3 to the Feasibility Index and Saturation Check, rules 4 and 7 to Methodology Builder, rule 6 to UGC Compliance Check, and rules 8–10 to the Research Gap Heatmap and Journal Recommender.
